We added something new to our sundowner this year 'The water drop station' and what better way to welcome our new school principal Mark Powell to the school and our teachers, Mr B, Mrs Caridi and Mrs Atkinson who volunteered to get dunked by the children made it a very exciting way to start the school year off.

We were happy again to be a part of and support the ride to school day in March providing a healthy morning snack for all the students.

We commenced term 2 a little different this year and with the many restrictions in place due to COVID, we saw our Dad's camp out, Hot Cross bun day and Semester 1 disco cancelled and we postponed our Mother's Day stall. It sure made term 2 a quite one.

Throughout the many fundraising events this year we have raised a total of \$ 4361.96. We have made purchases of a new Triple station easel for Kindy, New Music Band Banners and contributed \$35,000 towards the playground upgrades.
