Principal's Report – Parents and Friends Meeting 20th April 2021

1. Assemblies, Masses and other events.:

2. COVID:

We received advice from the State Government that restrictions to school events have now been lifted and we are now back to 100% capacity. Parents will be notified that they will now be able to attend assemblies and Masses as before. The new regulations state that people still need to be aware of physical distancing and personal hygiene.
