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Parent & Friends President Report 15th June 2021

During the month of May, The Good Shepherd Parents and Friends (P&F) were gifted 98 Ex-classrooms iPads by our School Advisory Council and Administration.

Within 5 hours of advertising via SEQTA to school families all iPads were secured via either SMS or email for purchase. No further advertising was required by the P&F outside of the school's communication resources.

A total of \$2,880 was fundraised.
\$30 @ 92 iPads = \$2760
\$20 @ 06 iPads = \$120

Pay and collect stalls were held on Monday, 31st May (morning) and Wednesday, 2nd June (afternoon) which once again ran very smoothly on both days. The committee would like thank Renee, Mark and Lisa for allowing us to have the collection of iPads on these days.

As a committee, we were overwhelmed with the families that supported this event and simply amazed at how quickly these iPads were sold. The demand for these iPads was once again very high and exceeded our expectations. There were several families that were either wait-listed (23 families) or just simply missed out trying to secure an iPad.

Overall, the P&F have received very positive feedback with regards to pricing and the quality of all devices.

Thank you to the School Advisory Council and Administration for allowing this no fuss, no frills fundraising event to be so successful, and we would welcome this opportunity again in 2022.
